Dear Colleagues,

Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), in 2009, advised Banks to establish one RUDSETI type institute in all their Lead Districts known as Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) to provide training to rural youth to take up self-employment / entrepreneurship ventures. RSETI program is a three-way partnership between the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) / GoI, State Governments and Sponsor Banks.

As per extant guidelines of MoRD, Banks are mandated to open at least one RSETI in their lead district to provide skill training to rural youth for gainful employment and their sustainable livelihood. RSETI program runs with an approach of short-term training & long-term handholding of entrepreneurs. The RSETIs have become established as pioneers in capturing the aspirations of the rural poor youth and turning them into profitable entrepreneurs by training them in the domain and entrepreneurial skills.

Our Bank has been entrusted to open 43 RSETIs which are spread over 23 Zones in 6 States. These are operationalized under registered trust i.e. “Star Swarojgar Prashikshan Sansthan”.

I am very much pleased with performance of RSETIs all of which have been graded as AA for the grading exercise 2021-22. As all RSETIs have achieved cumulative target of credit linkages & settlement, I advise all RSETI to achieve 80% settlement and 60% credit linkage, during the FY 2022-23.

Once again I appreciate the efforts put in by team RSETIs / respective Zones/ and team HO-FI and wish all the very best for endeavor to achieve the targets.

Message from General Manager (HO-FI)



Dear Colleagues,

Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) - GOI was impressed by the RUDSETI model and advised Banks to establish one RUDSETI type institute in all their Lead Districts known as Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs). RSETI, a replicated model of RUDSETI is a unique initiative which not only imparts training but also extends continuous handholding support for two years.

As per MoRD / GOI extant guidelines, all public sector Banks were required to open RSETIs in all Districts where they are shouldering Lead Bank responsibilities. These RSETIs aimed at providing trainings to rural youths and ensure adequate skill developments to have self-sustained employment opportunity by virtue of their improved working knowledge and also through hand holding of eligible candidates by Banks.

All our 43 RSETIs are headed and managed by scale II / III officers, below the age of 45 years and are deployed for a minimum period of 3 years. As per SOP (MoRD), all RSETI have been provided supporting staff i.e. 2 faculties, 2 office Assistant, 1 Attendant and 2 Watchman cum Gardener. From Head Office, Financial Inclusion department is looking after and monitoring RSETIs and is in liasoning with MoRD, NACER, NIRD, concerned Directors, SDRs, Zones and LDMs.

Put together, since inception all our RSETIs have achieved national target of settlement 70% & credit linkage 50% whereas during the financial year up to the quarter ended December 2022, the percentage of settlement & credit linkage was 62.45 & 53.58 respectively. Active involvement of LDMs, ZO officials and branches can result in improvement on credit linkages & settlement of the trained candidates. Out of 43 RSETIs, our 33 RSETIs are operating from their own building and remaining 10 RSETIs are operating from rented house or building provided by District authority. Process of allotment of land and construction building is going on and 2 RSETI buildings are expected to complete in coming 6 months.

Our endeavor is to make our RSETIs the best Training Centre PAN India with an achievement of 100% Annual Action Plan (AAP), settlement and credit linkage.

At last, I compliment all RSETI Directors, concerned ZMs, LDMs FI Nodal officer and RSETI supporting staff members for their endeavor to achieve the object of the scheme.

Editorial



Dear Readers,

RSETI (Rural Self Employment Training Institute) is an initiative of Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) for skilling up rural people to ensure sustainable income for their livelihood. RSETI is a partnership among Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), GoI, State Governments and Sponsor Banks. The Banks are mandated to open at least one RSETI in their lead district to provide training to rural youth to take up self-employment/ entrepreneurship ventures. RSETIs are mainly providing training to Rural poor youth between the age group of 18-45 years to make them self-employed.

RSETI is governed by 3 committees namely, 1. National Level Advisory Committee on RSETIs (NLACR) chaired by Secretary MoRD (half yearly meeting), 2. State Level Steering Committee on RSETIs (SLSCR), Principal Secretary (RD), State Govt. (half yearly meeting) and 3. District Level RSETI Advisory Committee (DLRAC), Chaired by DC / CEO of DRDA (quarterly meeting).

At present total 590 RSETIs are functioning across the country. These RSETIs are sponsored by 24 Bank (Public & Private). MoRD is funding building construction cost and training costs through respective State NRLM to sponsoring Bank. Till the December 31, 2022, put together, all RSETI have trained 43.90 lakhs candidates.

NACER (National Centre for Excellency of RSETI) an aegis of MoRD monitoring RSETI through SDR (State Director of RSETI) deployed by MoRD and we are monitoring RSETI from Head Office, Financial Inclusion department through concerned Zonal office & LDMS in liasoning with NACER / MoRD / concerned State NRLM / SLBC.

We are sponsoring 43 RSETIs. Since inception, put together, all our 43 RSETIs have trained approx. 3.00 lakh candidates, so far, out of which 2.11 lakhs (70.36%) have been settled and 1.02 lakh (50.81%) have been credit linked.

RSETI, a part from imparting training to rural youth, provides different types of training i.e. PMEGP, one GP one BC, Bank BC, training sponsored by NABARD, KVIC, DIC, training programme sponsor by different Govt. department / Ministries etc.

I, as a Nodal officer of BoI (HO), looking after & monitoring all affairs of RSETIs including implementation of SOP / Common Norms Notifications of regulatory in liasoning with MoRD, NACER, NAR, NIRD&PR, RBI, NABARD etc.

It gives me immense pleasure that our all sponsored RSETIs are graded as AA and MoRD appreciates our sponsor RSETIs for excellent performance. Some of our RSETIs are recognised as model RSETI by NACER i.e. Solapur, Barabanki.

Our Executive Director advised to showcase the good work done by our RSETI and that's the reason it has been decided to publish compendium on our RSETIs on regular basis.

We welcome suggestions for making this more informative & meaningful..

BOI SPONSORED RSETIs, AT A GLANCE

- In terms of MoRD, GOI extant guidelines all public sector Banks were required to open RSETIs in all Districts where they were shouldering Lead Bank responsibilities. These RSETIs aimed at providing trainings to rural youths and ensure adequate skill developments to have self-sustained employment opportunity by virtue of their improved working knowledge and also through hand holding of eligible candidates by Banks.
- Accordingly, we have opened 43 RSETIs, out of which 42 RSETIs are in our Lead Districts and one at Barasat (West Bengal), which is in a non- Lead district. Similarly eight RSETIs though located in our Lead Bank locations (viz. Bhopal, Ranchi, Hazaribagh, Ramgarh, Sarikelan Kharswan, Agar-Malwa, Indore and Nagpur) but are being managed by other Banks, allotted to them abinitio. PAN India, presently 590 RSETIs are operationalized under sponsorship of different scheduled Commercial Bank and RUDSETI.
- As per directions of MoRD, all our RSETIs are operating under umbrella of Star Swarojgar Prashikshan Sansthan, registered under Society with Bombay Charity Trust. All our sponsor RSETIs are being managed & monitored by HO. Financial Inclusion.
- GRADING OF RSETIs:-**
- National Centre for Excellence of RSETIs

(NACER) an aegis of Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India conducts grading exercise of all RSETIs regularly on annual basis. Grading exercise is based on major parameters like training programs conducted, achievement of Annual Action Plan (AAP), deployment of man power, infrastructure, number of trainees settled / credit linked with Bank, alignment of RSETI with Common Norms Notification (CNN) as per SOP. Last Grading exercise of RSETI for FY 2021-22 was conducted in the month of July-August 2022 by Grading official appointed by NACER (an aegis of MoRD). **[During the grading exercise for FY 2021-22, all our 43 RSETIs have been graded as “AA”].**

Land Allotment Status:-

- In term of extant guidelines of MoRD / GOI, land for RSETI is to be allotted by the State Government free of cost and thereafter MoRD provides building grant fund of Rs.1.00 crore. Now building grant fund has been increased to 2 Crore for new project vide MoRD Circular date 18.02.2022. Out of 43 RSETIs, land so far allotted to 41 RSETIs by the concerned State Govt. In two locations viz. *Gondia & **Barasat land is yet to be allotted.

Asha Malviya belongs to Sali, where she had studied up to 12th from Government Girls School . Her husband is working as a daily labour on building construction sites and he earned hardly 200-250 Rs per day. His earnings of daily wages was not sufficient to fulfill needs of his family with two kids. Asha was motivated by NRLM coordinator to join SHG for employment and financial needs. Through NRLM & RSETI Barwani awareness programme she came to the know the working of Bank Sakhi. NRLM Barwani shortlisted her for the BANK SAKHI (1 GP 1 BC) training programme to be conducted at RSETI Barwani.

Asha was guided about NRLM SHG concept and Banking Correspondence work profile. She received a training of 6 days of BANK SAKHI from RSETI Barwani and she successfully passed the **IIBF BC/BF examination**.

Asha Malviya got financial support as SHG loan/Mukhyamantri Swarojgar Yojna through NRLM Rajpur, through which she started her own Common service centre of MPGB at Sali. Through RSETI Bank Sakhi training she learned competencies and skills like **effective communication, goal orientation & time management with duties and work profile of BC** are achieved by her and because of regular support received through RESTI, she managed to take moderate risks of starting an enterprise with a self investment of 35000 which she had saved through out his life and received a loan of 25000 from MPGB Bank results to be a back support to run his enterprise.

As from RSETI concept she learned about quality work more important than quantity, because of which she had been considered as a successful entrepreneur and also named as **Bank Sakhi didi** in her village Bhagsur block Rajpur in Barwani District.

- The candidate after completing his graduation searched for job. He has no idea about Self Employment. As per the candidate his risk taking capability was very low at that time. He had also no idea about how to get finance and maintain bank account properly.
- During his struggling period one of official of BOI Kashempur sent him to Director RSETI Barasat for taking guidance & training.
- He enrolled himself and taken training at RSETI Barasat. After training he has been guided and motivated about need and benefits of self-employment. Then he took loan from Bank and started jewellery box making factory very small scale M/s MAA Enterprise. The industry gradually increased. He was very thankful to the training of RSETI.
- At present during post COVID situation he is maintaining 4 employees in his factory. Laser cutting, computerized designing equipment has been installed by him. Now he is one of the best designer of the jewellery box. His business has expanded all over India.

- निर्धनता और उससे जुड़ी अन्य कठिनाइयों के कारण पिंकी कुमारी कक्षा 10 के बाद शिक्षा प्राप्त नहीं कर पाई अतः वह अपने पति के साथ खेतों में कड़ी मेहनत कर आजीविका कमाने में लग गयी। इस कार्य से मिली कम आय उनका जीवन चलने में असमर्थ थी। एकांत में वह अक्सर अपने पति और बच्चों की दशा सुधारने के सपने देखा करती थी किन्तु साथ ही वह यह भी जानती थी की ऐसा करने हेतु न तो उसके पास कौशल था, और न ही धन ऐसी निराशा भरी परिस्थितियों में पिंकी को आरसेटी , बोकारो के कर्कलाप के बारे में पता चला. इसके पश्चात् वह वहाँ के डायरेक्टर से मिली और अपनी व्यथा सुना सहायता की गुहार की महिलाओं के लिए संस्थान द्वारा कई प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किये जाते हैं किन्तु समस्या यह थी की पिंकी को इनमें से किसी भी कार्य की रती भर भी जानकारी नहीं थी। अतः यह पिंकी और संस्थान दोनों के लिए ही एक चुनौतीपूर्ण कार्य था ।
- हालाँकि उसने यह प्रशिक्षण उत्साहपूर्वक संपन्न किया और एक पुरानी सिलाई मशीन लेकर बच्चों एवं महिलाओं के कपडे तैयार करना शुरू कर दिया धीरे धीरे उसके ग्राहकों की संख्या बढ़ने लगी और अब वह रु. 8000/- मासिक कमा रही है

- नाम :- लक्ष्मी देवी ऐसी जगह से तालुक रखती है, वहां की बेटी-बहु बहुत ही कम घर से बाहर निकलती है, लक्ष्मी की तमन्ना थी की वो खुद की पैरो पर खड़ा हो सके, पर घर की आर्थिक स्थिति ठीक नहीं थी, कही उम्मीद नहीं दिख रहा था, एक दिन लक्ष्मी के ही बगल में आरसेटी का जागरूकता शिविर लगा और वह उस शिविर में भाग लि वहा बताया गया की , मुफ्त में गरीब लोगों को स्वयं का रोजगार शुरू करने के लिए ट्रेनिंग दी जाती है, लक्ष्मी काफी संतुष्ट हुई। आरसेटी में आकर फॉर्म भरी कुछ दिनों के बाद ब्यूटी पार्लर का ट्रेनिंग शुरू हुआ, और वह उसमें सम्मिलित हुई, ट्रेनिंग समाप्त होने के बाद कुछ पूंजी अपने घर से लगाई, पहले वो खुद के घर से पार्लर का काम स्टार्ट किया , धीरे-धीरे मेरा मेहनत रंग लाना लगा , और जायदा पूंजी लगा कर पार्लर का सेटअप और फर्नीचर बनवाएं, काफी ग्राहक दुकान पर आने लगे, आज के समय में लक्ष्मी अपने पैरो पे खड़ी हो गयी है। लक्ष्मी अपने परिवार का भरण-पोषण भी कर रही है और महीना में 7000 रुपया कमा रही है, साथ ही लोगो को जागरूक भी कर रही है आरसेटी परिवार को दिल से शुक्रिया देती है ।

- Name of the Training Program : Vegetable Nursery Management & Cultivation

Keshaba Behera is staying at Akul Village under Telkoi block in keonjhar district. He belongs to an agriculture family and faced many hardships in life. He is the only earning member of the family. Being a farmer son, he has already ability of farming. After he came to know about the RSETI through one of his friends. He decided to join Vegetable Nursery management & Cultivation programme.

After that, he has become an inspiration for youths shying away from agriculture. Keshaba, who is into vegetable cultivation for the last 5 years, has made farming a lucrative business and is earning profit of approx.Rs 2.30 lakh per annum.

Keshaba, who has studied up to Class XII, started vegetable cultivation at an age of 22. His started with cultivation of pointed gourd (potal), Green Chilly and cabbage over about 2.0 acres of land. Before he ventured into farming, his father Maheswar Behera was solely concentrating on paddy cultivation. Keshaba took up vegetable cultivation after being informed that it offers good return.

Keshaba said he earns around Rs 40,000 annually from bitter gourd cultivation over half an acre and another Rs 50,000 by growing pointed gourd over 1 acres. Similarly, he cultivates French beans and earns a profit of about Rs 40,000. He also gets around Rs 40,000 to 50,000 from potato and about Rs 50,000 from cultivation of cabbage, cauliflower, cowpea and bottle gourd.

Keshaba said he faces no problem in selling his yield as traders visit his village regularly to procure his produce. "I have never felt the need of a job and am satisfied with farming".

- Nandini Mahanta is staying at Kendua Village under sadar block in keonjhar district. She belongs to an agriculture family. Due to low income, she decided to do something for increasing their economic status. By the help of BPM and BLC of Mission shakti they came to know about the RSETI. They decided to join Mushroom Cultivation training at RSETI, which will help in starting a self employment activity with low investment. She took training in cultivation and preservation of different types of mushroom.
- As “Dhingri” Mushroom is tasty, and it has good demand in the market, Nandini started mushroom cultivation with a small investment, and initially she purchased seeds for 10 bags of mushroom and produced 40 kg of mushroom. “she conveyed that she had invested Rs. 1000 and got Rs.1800 in return in a month” . As SHG group saw the profitability in the business, started this business though SHG (Maa Gramyadevi), and invested Rs. 1, 50,000/- funded by Union Bank, Keonjhar Bank. With the entrepreneurial skills learnt at RSETI, they are trying to expand their business further. Today they have gained a good client base in local vegetable market and even transport mushrooms to nearby cities. Today earning around Rs. 5000/-to 10000/- per month each. Expressing her thanks to the RSETI, she says “RSETI has changed our destiny and has presented a bright future to our family”
